

# Snark Sailboat Manual Waterbug or Ladybug

Follow the step-by-step instructions on the following pages to assemble your Waterbug. The job will go more quickly if you round up all the necessary tools in advance. You will need a screwdriver; pliers or a small adjustable wrench; a knife, and matches or a cigarette lighter (to seal the ends of the nylon lines so they won't unravel).

As with virtually every activity, there are basic rules you should know—and follow—in order to help assure that sailing will be a safe, enjoyable pastime for you and your family.

For example, the U.S. Coast Guard requires that every person on your boat have an approved life jacket or other flotation device at all times. It is a good idea tomake it a practice to wear your life jacket whenever sailing.

You should also have a basic understanding of prevailing current and wind conditions on the waters where you sail, and avoid areas where severe conditions are common. Check the weather before you set out for a day's sailing. Stay within sight of land and plan your activities to allow ample time to be ashore well before nightfall.

Your Waterbug cannot sink, but always remember any sailboat can capsize. Learn the proper procedures for righting a capeized boat. And, if you do capsize, stay with your boat. Shore is always farther away than it locks.

#### RULES FOR SAFE BOATING

#### A.

Before operating your boat, read the SNARK SAILING MANUAL carefully and be thoroughly familiar with the rules for safe operation.

#### B.


Do not overload your boat. Capacities are clearly stated on the CAPACITY INFORMATION PLATE located on the transom of the boat.

#### C.


The Waterbug is a small boat and caution must always be used, particularly when operating on open bodies of water where conditions can be unexpectedly severe.

#### D.

Always carry a Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device for each person aboard and check with local authorities for regulations governing registration and operation of your boat. If capsizing should occur, stay with your boat until help arrives. It will not sink and is far easier for rescuers to see than a lone swimmer.
